The County Planning Department is the administrator of all Act 167 – Stormwater Management Plans, and provides technical assistance in the development of required stormwater management ordinances. The Conservation District has served on every Watershed Plan Advisory Committee (WPAC). The 167 process also requires public meetings as part of the plan development process. In Year 6 we continued to work on the Crum Creek 167 Watershed Plan.
