

### **I. Target Audience**

A County differs from a local municipality. First our program will only deal with land that is directly owned and operated by the County. All individuals utilizing County owned and operated facilities must follow the rules and regulations adopted by the County. Every facility is managed by a Department Head, and depending on the size of the facility several key staff.
