CONTEST RULES

1. ****NEW**** Poster must be "14 x 22".
2. Written title or slogan using "Watersheds: Our Water, Our Home" must appear on the front of the poster.
3. Posters will be judged in the following grade categories: K-1, 2-3, 4-6, 7-9, 10-12.
4. No artist's name may appear on the front of the poster.
5. One poster per student and one student per poster.
6. Posters must be flat. No 3-D object may be attached to the poster.
7. Types of art materials that can be used include: crayons, colored pencils, water-colors, markers, paints, charcoal, stickers, paper, or other material.

Additional Information

You may complete the chart on the backside of this brochure and attach it to the back of the poster or write the student's information on the back of the poster. Posters may be mailed or dropped off at our office.

Please take special care in reading and following the rules. The most common problem is that many posters lack the current theme. The posters must very closely resemble the "Watersheds: Our Water, Our Home" theme.
